WHO WILL BE GOING TO WASHINGTON, DC ON THE FRS YOUTH TOUR?

This June, HTC will sponsor two High School juniors to be among the 100 students to attend the Foundation for Rural Service's 2010 Youth Tour in Washington, D.C. The tour is scheduled from June 5-9, and gives participants a first-hand look at the telecommunications industry and the legislative process by visiting Congress, the Federal Communications Commission (FCC) and other governmental agencies. HTC must select **two** qualified candidates based on the following requirements.

Students should:

- ❖ Be a high school junior;
- ❖ Have at least a C grade point average (GPA) or better;
- ❖ Demonstrate leadership in organizations and interest in community through volunteer activities;
- ❖ Write a letter explaining why he or she would like to attend and stating his or her future plans beyond high school;
- ❖ Obtain a letter of recommendation from a teacher or school official.

Parent must be an HTC member.

Guidance counselors are responsible for recommending one student to represent their high school by completing an application form. Nominations for the 2010 Youth Tour are due February 18. After each application is carefully reviewed, two students will be selected from all nominees by March 18, 2010.
